Privacy Policy Auburn Counselling and Psychotherapy

This Privacy Policy governs the manner in which Auburn Counselling and Psychotherapy collects, uses, and maintains information collected from users (each, a "User" of the Auburn Counselling.ie website ("Site"). This privacy policy applies to the Site and all products and services offered by Auburn Counselling and Psychotherapy.

Personal identification information

We may collect personal identification information from when Users visit our site and fill out a form. Users may visit our Site anonymously.
